You will be paying to install the scheme and then fleeced with a daily charge. It's about money not health.




## Why should you pay more to drive inside the middle ring road in Birmingham?

This will mean a daily charge of between £6 and £12.50 for private cars. Or £50 to £100 for commercial vehicles.

If you don't pay, the fine will be £120 with strict camera enforcement.
